THE TALYLLYN RAILWAY

Built to carry slate from the Bryn Eglwys Quarry, and opened in 1865, the Talyllyn was the first narrow gauge railway in Britain to be approved to carry passengers. It runs 71/4 miles from Tywyn along an unspoilt valley and over the dramatic Dolgoch Viaduct to Nant Gwernol. This film was shot in 1990 to celebrated 40 years of preservation and includes driver's eve views!

We also see 44903 departing Haymarket before moving on to Thornton Junction with B1s, a J36 and J37s, Aberdeen Ferryhill. Dundee Tay Bridge Depot and much more!



VOLUME 2: SALISBURY TO THE WEST COUNTRY AND THE SOMERSET & DORSET

The introduction starts at Nine Elms depot and Waterloo, from where we depart hauled by 34013 Okehampton with short scenes at Woking and Basingstoke. Other locations featured include Salisbury. VOLUME 3: WATERLOO TO WEYMOUTH

Soon after leaving Waterloo, we see steam near Esher on engineers' trains with the first stop-off at Woking. Guildford is visited in the middle of a snow storm, and other locations featured are the Ocean Liner Terminal in Southampton Docks, Southampton Central, Brockenhurst, Bournemouth Central and Poole before arriving at Weymouth Quay - plus priceless shots of the varied locos at the town's shed!



VOLUME 4: FROM THE CAMBRIAN TO CARLISLE

The Cambrian line is shown on a summer Saturday in 1966 with double-headed Standards on holiday trains, Machynlleth shed and station, and a journey to Pwllheli. The Liverpool area is covered in depth, before moving on to Cumbria. RIDINGTHE ROG LOCO MOVE NO. 2

Climb on board Class 57/3, 57310 'Pride of Cumbria' from Norwich Crown Point depot to the UKRL depot at Leicester! The working here was a light engine move to collect the failed 37608 from Norwich and return it to Leicester. This interesting journey passes through miles of rural scenes punctuated by century-old signal boxes, lovely semaphore signals and picturesque stations.



RIDING THE ROG LOCO MOVE NO. 3 CAB RIDE: CARLISLETO NORTHALLERTON

An exciting cab ride on board Class 37/7, 37884 Cepheus along the scenic Tyne Valley and Durham coast. Avoiding Newcastle, we are routed via Gateshead and then - a rare experience on a Class 37! - we share the lines of the Tyne and Wear Metro towards Sunderland. Highlights along this historic route, which has a number of freight-only curves, include a view of Yarm's impressive viaduct.

Hold on tight for some thrills and spills aboard a Thameslink Class 387! For the entirety of our trip we will be using the 750 volt third rail. The service stops at several locations, including Gatwick Airport, where we can enjoy the sight of two low aircraft on final approach to the runway, a short distance west of the station.


